THE VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE

Cape bulk carrier charter rates have sunk to near historical lows. The BCI closed at 150, yes 150, which is a massive drop compared to 12 months ago when it was close to 1100! Monday's Baltic Capesize Index (BCI) route 5TC posted an index down -145 to settle at \$4,035/day and by Friday finished at \$3,796/day.

There were reports that Vale's iron ore production will be reduced by at least 50 mill. tons this year and their supply could be disrupted until 2024 according to forecasts/analysis by Australia's Department of Industry, Innovation and Science.

"The majority of the impacted supply is high-grade iron ore (65% Fe content), and there is little alternative high-grade supply to make up for the short fall," the department said. Iron ore inventory at Chinese ports remains high at over 120 million tons of mostly lower grade iron ore, following restocking in February ahead of Chinese New Year, according to the report.

"The Vale dam collapse is expected to decrease seaborne supply, and inventories are expected to decline in 2019, as steel makers blend in lower-priced ores to help buffer profit margins," the department stated.

As you can see on page 5 of our report today, there have been 13 Capes sold for recycling so far in 2019 compared with 5 to this date in 2018. With stronger freight rates in 2018 there were only 19 Capes recycled compared with 38 sold for demolition in 2017.

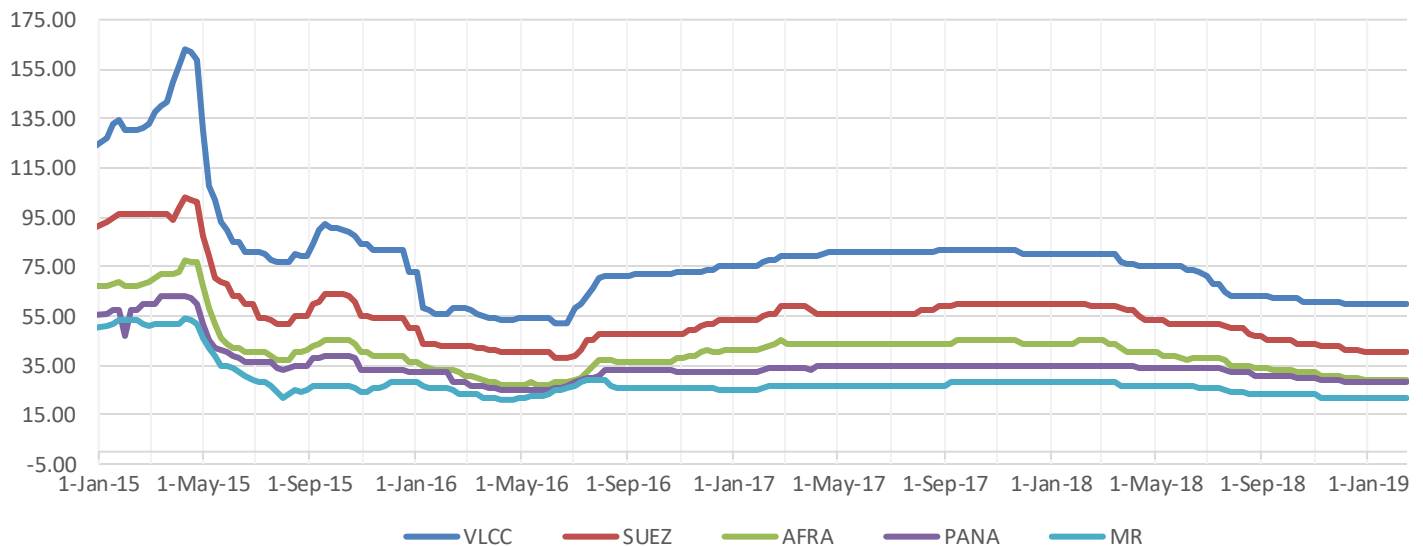

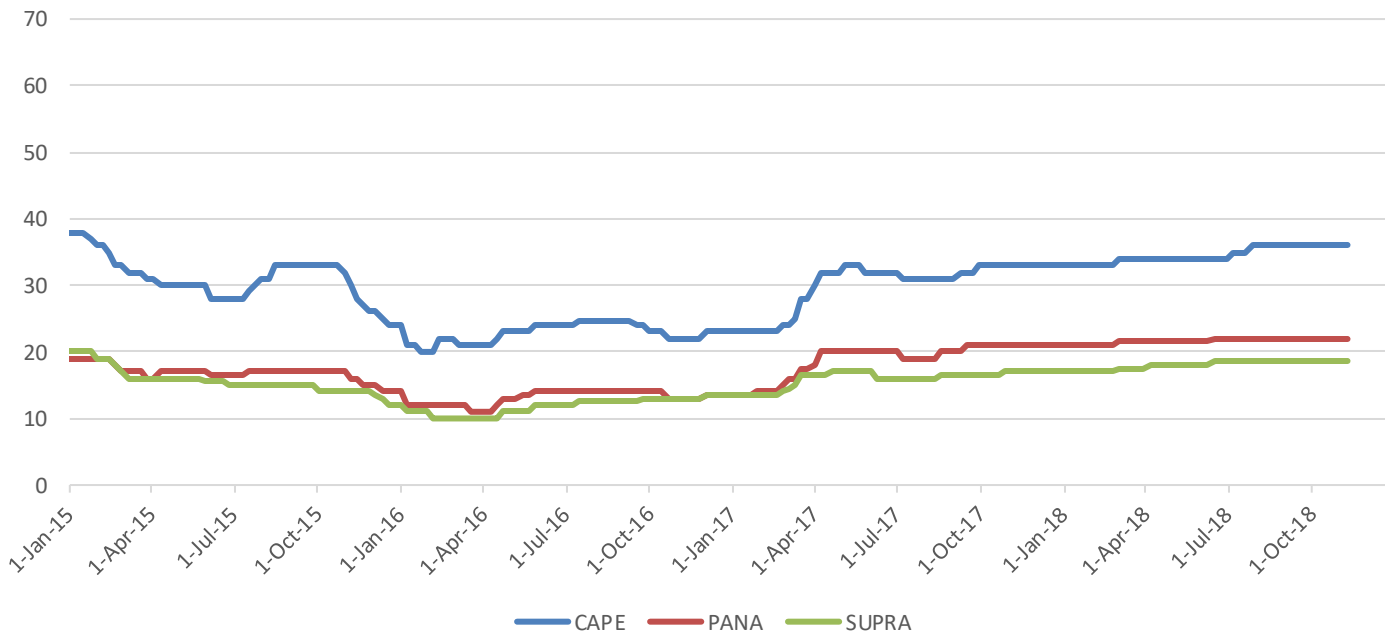
