# THE VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE

Newbuildings, Newbuildings!

In the past few year's newbuilding orders have been dominated by Container vessels (now seeing softening trade demand and orders now more focused on smaller than 8,000 TEU's vessels) and LNG & LPG carriers, but recently there have been plenty of Tanker and Bulk Carrier orders being placed with increasing numbers.

The orders keep coming despite dual fuel uncertainty, higher ship prices (up over 35% since January 2020), higher interest rates, and tight shipyard capacity with delivery slots not available until late 2026/early 2027.

In the past week or so we have seen more than 40 vessels ordered including 10+ Bulk Carriers (Newcastlemaxes, Kamsarmaxes, Ultramaxes, and Handymaxes) and 20+ Tankers (Suezmax, MR 2's, and 13,000 DWT Stainless chemical tankers).

About 5,250+ vessels are currently on order costing over \$350+ bill. with 94% of the global orderbook dominated by shipyards in China (52%), Korea (30%), Japan (12%)! China has seen the largest growth in market share and is catching up with high value vessels.

Orders have been placed by shipowners from China (24%), Japan (11%), Greece (10%), Singapore (6%), France (5%), Korea (5%), Switzerland (5%), UK (3%), Norway (3%) and Denmark (3%).

Almost 40% of the global orderbook is dual fuel main engines. China and Korea orders are led by Ammonia, Liquid carbon Dioxide (LCO2) & Dual fuel power plants with Japan leading the way with Hydrogen fuel.




