THE VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE

On April 18th the USTR released their updated Proposed Action 301 regarding collection of Port Fees at U.S. ports from Chinese built ships. After receiving input from nearly 600 public comments at hearings in Washington D.C. and consulting with government agency experts and USTR cleared advisors, they issued their revised action plan.

The revised plan affects much fewer tanker (under 55,000 DWT) and bulk carrier Owners (under 80,000 DWT) and will have much lower impact on ship prices than expected from the initial structure of the plan.

- *Bulk carriers with a capacity of up to 80,000 deadweight will be exempt.
- *Tankers with a capacity of up to 55,000 deadweight will be exempt.

A few highlighted points:

- *For the first 180 days the applicable fees will be set at \$0.
- *Fees applicable max 5 times per calendar year per vessel. The charges are per U.S. call and not per U.S. port.

Annex I:

Fees applicable to Chinese Owned (citizen, corporate, shareholding, voting rights registered in PRC, Hong Kong, or Macau), Operated, Controlled, vessels built in China.

- * \$50 per net ton from October 14, 2025.
- * \$80 per net ton from April 17, 2026.

and so on until 2028

Annex II:

Chinese built but NON-CHINESE vessel operators (especially Container carriers or Bulk Carriers).

- * \$18 per Net Ton or \$120 per container (whichever is greater) from October 14, 2025.
- * \$23 per Net Ton or \$153 per container (whichever is greater) from April 17, 2026.

and so on until 2028

Ship owners will still have uncertainty over investment planning/calculating decisions until more details of the plan are understood and absorbed.

There are many details that may have room for negotiation over the next 180 days and we expect will be clarified in the near term. We also expect that there will be more negotiations between the USTR and the China Association of the National Shipbuilding Industry (CANSI) plus the China Shipowners' Association (CSA).




