### THE VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE

The international shipping community awaits the geopolitical results of the July 9th Tariff deadline and the October 14th U.S. Port fees plan (with amendments) targeting Chinese owned/linked vessels to create a Maritime Security Trust Fund and especially to see how both initiatives will affect Vessel prices and availability.

The One Big Beautiful Bill Act legislative package that was signed July 4th included several new initiatives to improve United States shipbuilding and funding of close to \$30 billion for the maritime industrial base:

 $1.\ Naval\ Shipbuilding\ \&\ Sealift\ Capacity\ Incentives\ \&\ Fees\ to\ Boost\ Domestic\ Build\ (including\ below)\ -\ \$29\ billion:$ 

- \$600 MILL.: NATIONAL DEFENSE SEALIFT FUND FOR SHIP LEASE/PURCHASE
- \$100 mill.: Building commercial logistics ships and oilers
- \$295 mill.: Landing Craft Units (LCU) shipyard Development & Production
- \$110 mill.: Rolled-steel and fabrication facilities
- \$400 mill.: collaborative naval shipyard campuses
- \$450 mill.: autonomy & Ai integration
- \$500 mill.: advanced manufacturing techniques
- \$500 mill.: increased dry-dock capabilities
- \$ 50 mill.: cold-spray repair tech
- \$450 mill.: maritime workforce development
- \$750 mill.: supplier base development in domestic shipbuilding
- \$250 mill.: advanced manufacturing across this base
- \$250 mill.: turbine generators for shipbuilding
- \$450 mill.: additive manufacturing, wiring, machining capacity
- \$492 mill.: next-gen shipbuilding techniques
- \$ 85 mill.: U.S. made ship steel plate
- \$ 50 mill.: propeller machining capacity
- 2. Strategic National Sea-Lift & Reserve Fleet \$400+ million
- \$100 mill.: for leasing Sea-Lift Vessels
- Building commercial logistics ships and oilers
- \$150 mill.: Enabling robust Inactive Reserve Fleet to ensure sealift during crises
- \$159 mill.: U.S. Marine Corps to charter ships.
- 3. Coast Guard Modernization \$25 billion
- \$4.4 bill.: shore infrastructure, training facilities, homeports
- \$4.3 bill.: Polar Security Cutters
- \$4.3 bill.: 9 Offshore Patrol Cutters
- \$3.5 bill.: 3 Arctic Security Cutters
- \$2.3 bill.: procurement of 40+ MH-60 helicopters
- \$2.2 bill.: depot-level maintenance




