THE VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE

The effect of geopolitical uncertainty on shipping continues to dominate the headlines during the past four months since the April 2025 implementation of sweeping tariffs by the United States and the almost daily roller coaster changes in tariff rates and dates of implementation which have caused worldwide confusion for importers, ship owners, charterers, insurers, etc.

These measures have led to significant disruptions in international trade flows, compelling shipping companies and related businesses to reassess their operations and strategies moving forward.

The most recent negotiations include secondary tariffs that will be levied on China and India for buying Russian energy etc. Tariffs on India were raised to 50% and negotiations continue with China.

Focusing on the container and container vessel market, one clear example of the volatility is Transpacific Container Rates (spot rates for moving containers from China to the U.S. West Coast per FEU - 40-foot equivalent unit) published by the Freightos-Baltic Assessment of Freight Rates.

Before the April 8th Announcement by the State Council Tariff Commission to raise the "reciprocal tariff" on Chinese goods exported to the U.S. from 34% to 84% the index rates were just below \$2,500/FEU which by end June had surged to about \$6,000/FEU from end May to the early July peak when shippers rushed to beat higher tariffs. In Mid-July rates started dropping significantly back to the \$2,500/FEU levels but in the past week they have fallen below \$2,000/FEU which is the lowest rate since the end of 2023.

The tariff issues affecting shipping are just one part of the uncertainty because there is the additional question of what will happen when the USTR port fees take effect from October 14, 2025!




