#### THE VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE

Geopolitical uncertainty is dominating the shipping headlines that influence ship prices and supply/demand of sales candidates. Here are a few examples:

**TARIFF & PORT FEE NEGOTIATIONS:** The U.S. and China have reached a preliminary consensus on how to address economic and trade issues regarding the U.S. Section 301 measures on China's maritime, logistics and Shipbuilding sectors and soybean trade expansion/purchases which will be finalized during this week's summit in Korea with President Trump and President Xi.

**SANCTIONS:** One third of all Aframax tankers globally have been blacklisted as the Shadow-sanctioned fleet continues to grow. The sanctioned "shadow fleet" now numbers 908 vessels, representing 16% of the global fleet.

U.S. SANCTIONS RUSSIAN OIL COMPANIES LUKOIL & ROSNEFT: Indian refiners are scaling back on their purchases of Russian crude oil.

SELLERS CANCEL DEALS WITH CHINESE OIL REFINER YULONG AFTER UK SANCTIONS: Several suppliers have cancelled sales of Middle Eastern and Canadian oil to China's Yulong Petrochemical after the UK imposed sanctions on the refiner, which is likely to push it to buy more Russian crude. Yulong is China's newest refiner with a capacity of 400,000 barrels per day. Reuters said TotalEnergies, BP and Saudi Aramco have halted shipments, as have Kuwait Petroleum Corp and Chinese state trader PetroChina International.

**IMO "NET ZERO" DECARBONISATION FRAMEWORK PLAN to 2050:** Delayed for one year by a 57-49 vote by delegates of the world's largest 35 flag states, which represent 93% of global tonnage, according to United Nations Trade & Development (Unctad) data and voting results. The vote against the plan was led by the world's biggest oil producers, Saudi Arabia and the U.S. plus the two largest flag states Panama and Liberia.




